The benefits paid for hospital treatment will depend on the type of cover you purchase and whether your fund has an agreement in place with the hospital in which you are treated. Under this policy, you may have to pay out-of-pocket costs above what you get from Medicare or your private health insurer. Before you go to hospital, you should ask your doctors, hospital and health insurer about any out-of-pocket costs that may apply to you.

The following payments may also apply for hospital admissions

Excess: You will have to pay an excess of \$500 per admission. This is limited to a maximum of \$500 per person and \$1000 per policy per year.

Excess payments do not apply to hospital admissions for dependants.

Co-payments: No co-payments

The following waiting periods for hospital admissions apply to new or upgrading members

Waiting periods:

- 2 months for palliative care, rehabilitation and hospital psychiatric treatments, even if pre-existing
- 12 months for other pre-existing conditions
- 2 months for all other treatments

Other features of this hospital cover

We do not have a preferred-provider-network-arrangement but operate a MediGap scheme aiming to eliminate the 'gap' payments for specialist fees in hospital. We do this by building a network of specialists who may agree to receive a higher benefit from us than they would ordinarily receive. In exchange, they do not charge you an out-of-pocket expense. Call-out fees: will be paid for each attendance, including emergency treatment without transport to hospital.
